## 7th Annual 2018 Simon Chaisson Alumni Tournament Rules

- 1. All games will be played under the "FIBA Official Basketball Rules".
- 2. Each team is to consist of players who attended their respective high schools unless special permission is granted by the tournament director (Aron Ashton).
- 3. Team Rosters must be provided to the tournament director prior to the start of the tournament. Only players on the roster are permitted to play.
- 4. All teams are required to have 5 players in order to start a game.
- 5. Each player is required to wear their team uniform in every game.
- 6. Round Robin play will consist of 3 games per team (4 for the High School All-Star team in the Men's Under 35 division). Games will consist of four 12 minute quarters (running time), with the exception of foul shots. During round robin play if overtime is necessary there will be one 5 minute period. If at the end of the 5 minute period the teams are still tied then the game will be considered a tie.
- 7. Team seeding will be based on best record. Tie breakers are as follows:
  - a. Head to head match up if only 2 teams are tied.
  - b. Plus/Minus during round robin play.
  - c. Points against during round robin play.
  - d. Points for during round robin play.
  - e. Coin flip.
  - f. **New Rule:** The maximum plus/minus possible in 1 game will be 20. (Example: Team 1 defeats team 2 87-54. Team 1 will only receive a +20 for seeding purposes, while team 2 will receive a -20 for seeding purposes)
  - g. **New Rule:** The high school all-star team (Men's 35+) will drop their worst game of the round robin.
- 8. Playoff Seeding: There will be 4 divisions on Sunday Women's, Men's 35+, Men's Under 35 A division, and Men's Under 35 B division. The top 6 seeded teams from round robin play in the Men's Under 35 division will play in the A division, while seeds 7-

12 will play in the B division. All 4 divisions will have 6 teams and the playoff format will be:

- a. Top 2 seeds in each division will receive a bye.
- b. Quarter Finals: Seed 3 will play Seed 6, Seed 4 will play Seed 5.
- c. Semi Finals: Top seed from round robin will play the lowest remaining seed from quarter final games. Second seed from round robin will play the second lowest remaining seed from the quarter finals.
- d. Championship: Winner of the two semi-final games.
- 9. Any disputes or disciplinary actions\* to be decided by the tournament committee.

\*Inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated. This behaviour includes, but is not limited to: fighting on or off the court, threats, verbal abuse, destruction of the gym facilities, and taunting. Any behaviour that is deemed inappropriate will be subject to discipline by the tournament committee which may include suspension for a game, or tournament.
